Vietnamese Language and Culture</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- This course is for students who would like to study the language and discover the culture of Vietnam.</li> <li>- This course is delivered in Korean, Japanese or English.</li> </ul> <p><b>2. <p><b>Eligibility</b></p>	<p><b>1. With Vietnamese Language and Culture:</b> Open to all undergraduate students of partner universities.</p> <p><b>2. With Regular Course for International Students</b> Exchange students are not required to submit English certificate but should show <b>intermediate level</b> of English proficiency (~IELTS 6.0, TOEFL 500 (ITP) or 60(iBT)) in order to attend all the classes and activities throughout the exchange period.</p>
<p><b>Transcript</b></p>	<p>We will both e-mail and post-mail student's official transcript to International Office of partner universities within TWO Months after the semester ends.</p>
<h3>IV. OTHER INFORMATION/EXPENSE</h3>	
<p><b>Airport pick up</b></p>	<p>HUFLIT will provide <b>free</b> pick-up services for exchange students. The preferable time is from 8:00 to 16:00 (GMT+7) on weekdays. Kindly inform the HUFLIT Coordinator about your arrival for better preparation.</p>

<b>Tuition fee</b>	<p>Tuition fee and admission fee shall be waived for <b>exchange students</b>. International students but not exchange students shall pay the same tuition fee and admission fee as normal HUFLIT students.</p> <p>The admission fee is \$28, while the tuition fee is counted by credits with \$40 - \$60/credit.</p>
<b>Textbooks</b>	\$25 - \$50/ semester (estimated)
<b>Food</b>	\$1.5 - \$3/ casual meal (estimated)
<b>Accommodation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Exchange students shall be supported in finding suitable accommodation nearby the campus (\$200 - \$250 /month) including: bed, internet, private bathroom, air conditioner and refrigerator.</li> <li>- Students should stay in a hotel during the time finding suitable rental rooms/apartments.</li> <li>- Students are recommended to find the accommodation themselves, but should report the address of the accommodation to the International relations coordinator of HUFLIT in order to be supported and protected if necessary.</li> <li>- If students find the accommodation themselves, always remember to make <b>a contract</b> with the owner. Then, a deposit of 1 month is usually required by the owner.</li> </ul>
